## **BD Tendering and Estimating**

Tendering opportunities for Red Eye remain positive with the team working to close out a number of projects. To date, for this Financial Year the Tendering team has secured an additional \$25M of work.

Recent Projects won include with construction on both projects commence this month:

Tuggerah Lakes Private Hospital: \$15 Million
 Day Surgery Fitout, Hurstville: \$3 Million

Upcoming Project opportunities for Interior Services include two (2) fitouts within the existing SOMA Health Hub project, Gregory Hills. If successful these projects would start in April / May:

SOMA Restaurant \$1 Million
 SOMA I-Med Radiology \$700K

We are also continuing discussions and pricing of a number of Construction Project opportunities:

The Hills Clinic Kellyville: \$8 Million
 The Vintage, Hunter Valley: \$15 Million
 South Coast (Wollongong) Private Hospital: \$10 Million
 Warehouse Facility, Holborn Crt Gregory Hills: \$10 Million

Other project opportunities include Dooman Reserve Sports Facility (\$3M) and Somerset Private Hospital (\$15M)

## **Projects**

#### **Tuggerah Lakes PH:**

Site works for this \$16 Million design & construct hospital Project have now kicked off Delegates from hospital operator Healthe Care joined local MPs and business leaders to turn the first sod on the project in late November.

The new hospital, located in Kanwal, directly opposite Wyong Public Hospital, includes 3 operating theatres, 14 recovery bays, 6 recovery chairs, 20 inpatient overnight beds and consulting spaces.

Once completed in late November this year, the facility will cater for Day Surgery and short stay patients for multiple specialties including orthopaedics, gastroenterology, ENT, plastics, urology, general surgery, and vascular among others.





#### **Brokenwood Winery:**

This \$4.5 Million Project involves the construction of a new cellar door — wine tasting room, lounge, restaurant and commercial kitchen with viewing area to the existing wine processing shed including adjacent carpark and terrace. The project team lead by Mark Bennellick and Col Masterton commenced civil works in early November with construction of the carpark, preparation of strip and pad footings along with the block retaining wall.





### **Mingara Medical Centre:**

The Mingara Medical Centre project is now complete with handover of the building just prior Xmas and the centre is now operational. The building internal main entry and staircase is an impressive as is the external design and finish. Congratulation to Dave Rennie and all the team involved on the project.



## **Brisbane Waters Private Hospital:**

This \$9.5 Million extension to the existing hospital is nearing completion with handover scheduled in the coming week. The project team of Jason Rose, Zac Nielsen and Nick Oliver have done a fantastic job in delivering this project which involved a single level construction with main entry, 24 bed ward, Oxygen cylinder enclosure and hydrotherapy pool.

A separate stage Mental Health facility was also awarded to RedEye with works commencing prior to Xmas and will continue through to April/May.







Our IT team has been working to document the setup of laptops to streamline the on-boarding process for new Red Eye employees. To provide better protection of laptops all new starters now receive a carry bag / back pack.

### **ChemALERT**

In November RedEye launched the Online ChemALERT system. ChemAlert is a leading chemical safety management system developed to provide a centralised database for the management of chemicals at ALL RedEye sites.

The system will be maintained by Alan Fuller, with access provided to all Project & Trades Managers including Supervisors.

#### **ChemALERT Features include:**

- Access to the ChemAlert database of original manufacturers' Safety Data Sheets (SDS).
- SDS continually updated to keep them within the 5 year validity period.
- Risk assessment capability, stock management system and reporting.

Access to the system is available via the Red Eye website.
